

Alexander Gegov is currently Associate Professor in Computational Intelligence in the School of Computing, University of Portsmouth, UK, and Visiting Professor in Control Theory in the English Faculty of Engineering, Technical University of Sofia, Bulgaria. In the past, he has held research positions at the Delft University of Technology, Netherlands (1997-1998), the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (1994-1997), the University of Wuppertal, Germany (1994-1994), and the University of Duisburg, Germany (1993-1994).

Alexander Gegov's research interests include machine learning, artificial intelligence and complex systems. His work involves the development and application of machine learning models and artificial intelligence systems for complex systems modelling. He has more than 150 peer reviewed publications including research monographs, book chapters, journal articles and conference papers. He is currently Associate Editor for IEEE Transactions on Artificial Intelligence and IEEE Transactions on Fuzzy Systems.
